

GENERIC CONTAINER / VEHICLE PACKING CERTIFICATE

The person **responsible for packing** the vehicle or container should:

1. Complete the checklist
2. Cross out 'vehicle' or 'container' as appropriate
3. Complete all information at the bottom
4. Date and sign the certification

It is hereby certified that the packing of container / vehicle No. _____ has been carried out in accordance with the following conditions:

- The freight container / vehicle was clean, dry and apparently fit to receive the goods.
- Goods which should be segregated have not been packed together in the freight container / vehicle, unless approved by the competent authority concerned in accordance with 7.2.2.3.
- All packages have been externally inspected for damage and only sound packages have been loaded
- Drums have been stowed in an upright position, unless otherwise authorized by the competent authority and all goods properly loaded and adequately braced with securing material.
- If the dangerous goods are in bulk packaging, the cargo has been evenly distributed in the container.
- If the consignment includes goods of class 1, other than division 1.4, the freight container / vehicle is structurally serviceable in conformity with section 7.4.6 of the IMDG Code.
- The freight container / vehicle and the package therein are properly marked, labeled and placarded.
- When solid carbon dioxide (dry ice) is used for cooling purposes, the freight container / vehicle is externally marked or labeled in a conspicuous place at the door end, with the words: DANGEROUS CO₂-GAS (DRY ICE) INSIDE, VENTILATE THOROUGHLY BEFORE ENTERING.
- The **dangerous goods declaration** required in Part 5, Chapter 5.4, Section 5.4.1, IMDG Code has been received for **each** dangerous goods consignment packed in the freight container / vehicle.
