Tampa, Florida (Port of Tampa)

<p><u>From the North or South:</u> <i>(From Palm Beach, Broward or North Dade counties)</i></p>
<p><u>** The Receiving Facility is Located Inside the Port **</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➔ Once at the Port, stay to your right and follow the blue signs with flashing orange lights through the gate and to the office ➔ <u>All non-badged visitors must stop here</u> and apply for a temporary badge to proceed. You are required to provide photo identification to receive authorization to enter the Port ➔ Badged visitors delivering Full Load Rack Cargo must stop here and check in (details below) ➔ Entrance is Berth 208 – Deliveries are Berth 209
<p>I-4</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take Exit 1 off I-4 to 21st Street South • Travel south approximately 3 miles to an intersection with a traffic light. This is Maritime Boulevard. • Turn right onto Maritime Boulevard. • This road leads directly to the Tampa Port Authority security area. • Once inside the security area, proceed to one of the open lanes to obtain a temporary port pass. (** see notation above) • Once temporary port pass has been issued, continue on Maritime Boulevard to East Port Drive (the first Stop sign) and turn left. • Proceed to the next Stop sign, which is Guy Verger Boulevard and turn right. • Travel approximately 8/10s of a mile to the entrance of Berth 208 (2802 Guy Verger Boulevard). • Stop at the guardhouse to obtain a gate pass. • Proceed forward and take the first right. • Proceed to the 2nd building on the left, which is the Ports America receiving office.
